After two long layoffs it was not unreasonable for some of Springboard's owners to question whether he could step out of the shadows and return successfully as a racehorse. He fortunately has looked great in his return, running twice third and once second. We have put him in six furlong competitions thus far, but he has shown us that he wants to try longer. So, expect to see him around two turns next time out and will hope the added distance suits him well.

Time Catcher Shares Available for Three More Days

Time Catcher is entered to make his first start on January 31st at the Fair Grounds. Time Catcher has always moved like a turf runner and is bred to go long. His sire, Temple City (by Dynaformer), did all his best work over turf and synthetic surfaces. His dam, Shiny Sheet, won the majority of her \$540,000 in purse earnings around two turns. Starting a horse at a mile the first time out is always a daunting task, but this is where he needs to be, now or later.

Shares can still be purchased in him at this point, but we will close the window of ownership after his first race. If you are looking to try thoroughbred ownership, there could be no better way to jump in

Sassy Kiss Claimed in 2014


