# Claiming Partnership Closes with Claim of Bull Dozer

There are some veteran horses out there, typically geldings, that defy all of the modern day statistics and simply run and run hard every time. Bull Dozer is one of those unique "war horses" of the modern era. With 50



races under his belt and nearly \$500,000 in earnings, this recently turned seven-year-old has been as consistent as they come. He has won 16 races and been in the top-3, thirty-three out of 50 starts.

We had the added advantage of this horse previously being trained by Bret Calhoun, so we had knowledge of the horse. After being claimed previously in May of 2013 for \$62,500 he was raced by the partnership of Bill Martin and Carl Moore until being claimed away in September of 2014 for \$62,500. Since then he has been shipped across country and continued to run, essentially having run almost every month for two straight years without a break. In our opinion, he was sound but running like a tired horse.

In our opinion, after 30-60 days of time away from the track, he should come back fresh and ready to race for the summer season in Kentucky. We shipped him up to Kentucky and turned him out immediately following the race and he is putting on

weight and doing well. We plan to bring him back into training in April.


Lone Star Park and plan to start him on April 10th in a 7.5 furlong Maiden Special Weight on the turf.

#### Slew City Lou Ships to Evangeline Downs

Slew City Lou will relocate to Evangeline Downs for the start of their meet on April 8th. Our tentative target for her is an April 9th Allowance race going one mile against nonwinners of three races in their lifetime.



Unfortunately, this is an open company race, but there is not a good two-turn opportunity restricted to La-breds until later in the month.



#### Perplexity Targets Oaklawn Race on April 9th

Perplexity ran 6th in her midmonth start, but she ran a better race than the sheets will show.

She was pinned down on the rail on a sloppy, slow track...the worst path...you guessed it -- on the rail. She showed early speed and was a game competitor until the elements simply took their toll. We have a few race options on the 9th and will pick the best opportunity we can to get her back into top form.

#### Wright Flyer Records a Second Place Finish

He was arguably the best horse in the race, but ran out of room and just could not get up for the win on March 20th at the Fair Grounds. Jockey Miguel Mena got a good break from Wright Flyer, but found himself pinned down on the rail and behind the leaders. Wright flyer advanced twice on the leaders only to have to steady because of the traffic. The one mile races at the Fair Grounds begin and end at the 1/16th pole, so the stretch is much shorter. When the pack finally straightened out in the home stretch, Wright Flyer moved for daylight, but did not have enough track



to mow down the leader. He showed good courage and should be able to win at this level next time out. .




#### Yankee Lady Breezing at Twin Oaks
